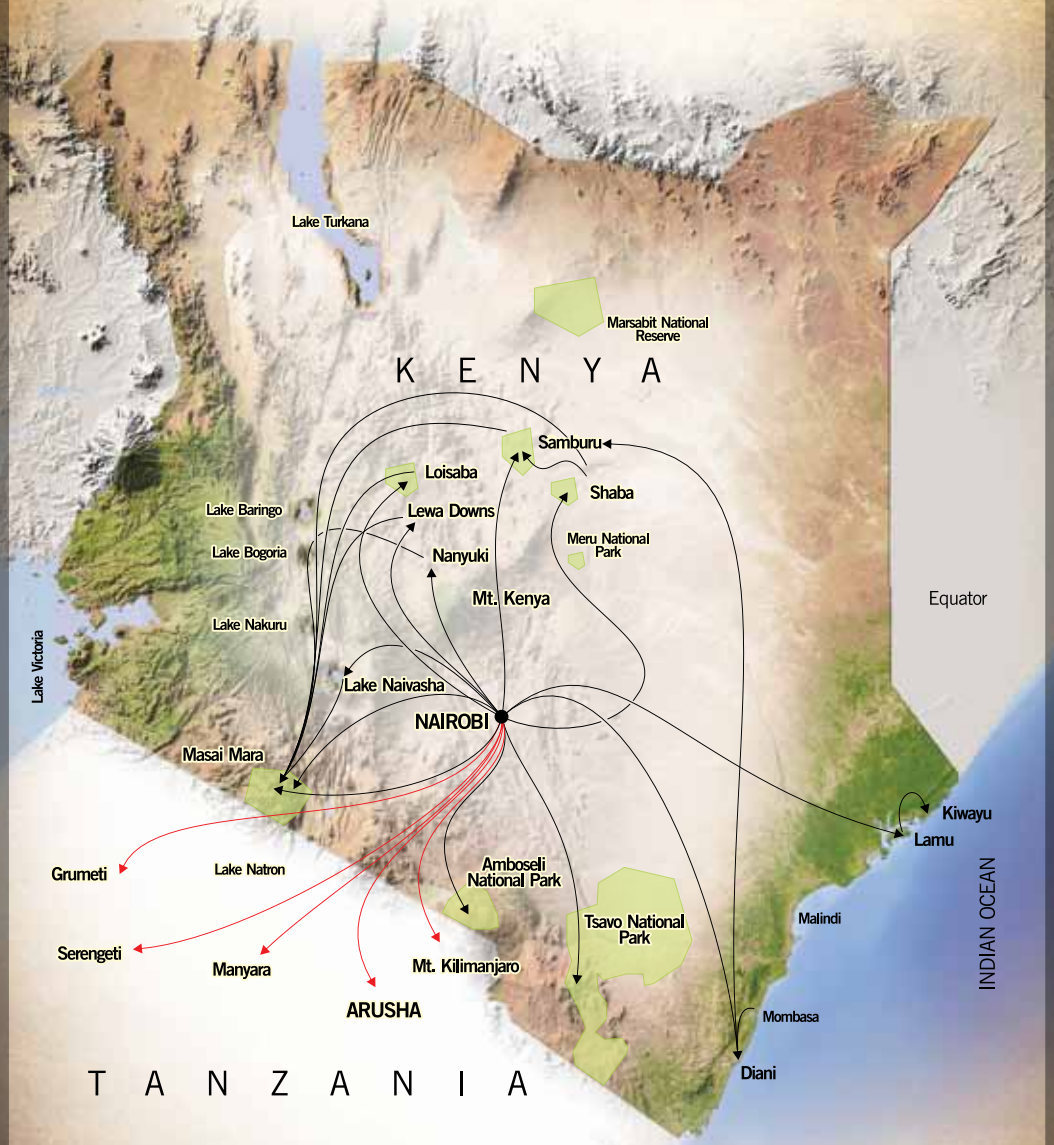

Safarilink is a Kenyan company established in 2004 by an experienced management team to provide air services for your clients. Based in the ALS Building, Wilson Airport, Safarilink offers a network of scheduled services that cover the main “safari” tourist destinations of Amboseli, Tsavo, Chyulus, Naivasha, Nanyuki, Lewa Downs, Samburu, Loisaba, Shaba, Masai Mara, Diani, Kiwayu and Lamu in Kenya and Kilimanjaro in Tanzania. In addition, Safarilink can provide you with charter flights within Kenya and throughout East Africa.

Safarilink currently operates a fleet of 8 Cessna Caravans, a Twin Otter and Dash 8, but through it's association with ALS (Aircraft Leasing Services), it has access to other aircraft such as Beechcraft Kingairs or B1900s to suit your specific requirements.

Phoenix Aviation carries out the maintenance of the aircraft under the approval of the Kenyan Civil Aviation Authority. All aircraft operating for Safarilink are insured in the London Market through Willis Ltd, which is one of the world's major aviation brokers, and aircraft have passenger and third liability cover between US\$ 20 million and US\$ 75 million depending on the seating capacity of the aircraft.

Safarilink's timetable has been constructed to provide convenient flight times and maximum inter - connectivity within its network, allowing clients to travel within Kenya in the shortest time possible, thereby saving valuable holiday time. For ease of reference, below is a list of services showing at a glance, the flight options and combination of services available:

- Clients arriving early morning can begin their safari almost immediately by flying to Amboseli, Loisaba, Shaba, Nanyuki, Samburu, Lewa Downs, Masai Mara, Lamu or Diani.

- The inbound Tsavo/Chyulus and Amboseli services connect immediately to Masai Mara, Nanyuki, Samburu, Loisaba, Shaba, Amboseli, Tsavo West and Lewa Downs or after a short wait at Wilson on to, Lamu, Kiwayu, Diani, Naivasha, or Kilimanjaro.
- The inbound morning service from Masai Mara connects immediately to Kilimanjaro, Diani, Lamu and Kiwayu.
- In addition to the morning flight from Samburu, Shaba, Loisab, Lewa Downs or Nanyuki to Masai Mara, there is an early afternoon service from Nanyuki, Loisab, Shaba, Lewa Downs or Samburu to Nairobi that connects immediately to Naivasha or Masai Mara.
- The inbound Samburu, Shaba, Loisaba, Lewa Downs and Nanyuki flight to Wilson, connects immediately to Lamu or Diani.

Safarilink's Kilimanjaro service connects with several Tanzanian airlines based in Arusha, offering Safarilink passengers convenient onward connections from Kilimanjaro to the northern circuit destinations such as Manyara, Seronera, Grumeti and others.
